# ACADEMIC ENGLISH TRACK

#### **Conditional OSU Admission**

Students who seek conditional admission to OSU, owing to test scores lower than the established cutoff (TOEFL 48-60 61, IELTS 5.0) are eligible to do their English language training in this program.




